Hebrew blessing thanking God for meeting needs

כִּי יָדַע אֲבִיכֶם מִה־מִּתְסוֹרְכֶם טֶרֶם תִּשְׁאַלוּ מִיָּדוֹ:

The *Kol Tsorki* blessing is sometimes said to express gratitude to the LORD for meeting your personal needs. Since God is the One who cares for the lilies of the field and knows the very number of the hairs on your head, surely this is a blessing that can be said on a daily basis:

she-'a-sah	li	kol	tsorki
who provides	for me	all	my needs

Blessed art thou, Lord our G-d, King of the universe,
who provides for me all my needs.
